## 2002~ 2014

**New Song began as a small group of new Christians who wanted to start a church and invited Tommy and Linda Gable to help them.**

### CRAZY BEGINNINGS

It was ludicrous to even think about starting a church in a foreign country, but when they asked us to we said, "If God will help us, we'll help you!" We were shocked to see how God poured blessings on us to get us down there. Between 2002 and 2007 the Gables and the Sellers made over 30 trips to Nicaragua to bring help and see the birth of this precious church

**We had no idea that God would birth a mission until 2004, when Samaritan's Purse gave us a matching grant to buy land and we began to pray on it asking. With gift of the land we began to dream with God to see a church, a clinic, gardens, sports fields and a dormitory to house US teams.**



### 2004 Sponsor-A-Student begins

Our first project began when the children asked us to help them go to school. With money raised to send 40 children to school, the leaders of the church went to work finding deals and eventually sent 119 children to school the first year. Each year the Lord has provided for 150+ children to attend school.

### Sponsor a Student 10 years later

Lisa Smith bravely took the responsibility for the program in 2011. Her love for the children and faithful diligence has created a well-organized program where the 350 Sunday school children in all 3 outreach churches are systematically being sponsored for school. The program is designed to keep them in school and care for their dental and medical needs as well as emergency care and extracurricular activities.





## Go and make disciples, baptise them and teach them everything Jesus said!

Since 2007, Tommy Gable has taught discipleship classes to the men of the community, focusing on the New Covenant of Jesus Christ. His goal has been to raise Pastors who will serve their communities with love. He teaches them from the Word and allows the Holy Spirit to transform their lives by grace, not the commonly-observed rules and regulations. Transformation of lives is happening all around us as a result, the men are becoming better husbands, fathers and community leaders. It is such a joy to hear them explain to their curious neighbors how Jesus has changed their lives! Here, churches are full of women and

children but the men are absent. With the strategy to reach out to the men we see the Lord lifting up the whole community

There are four pastors and each of them assist in the central church and also visit, pastor and preach in their rural outreach church. Their love and example has drawn more men who are helping with the work of the ministry.

Each week, 20 men arrive eager to receive the training and full of testimonies of what has been doing in their churches!

Once a month, we fill up the central church as we bring all four churches together for a joint worship service and night of great joy.

## ‘I want you to build a Dental Clinic’

When the Lord directed us to begin building a Dental Clinic in 2007, it was against all odds. We had been doing rural clinics for 4 years but this dream seemed beyond us. Everyone told us we couldn’t do it but because we felt the Lord had directed us to build a clinic, we began and did not stop until it was completed!



## 3 full time Nicaraguan Dentists

New Song clinic is serving Chichigalpa and the surrounding areas with three dentists and one part-time orthodontist. We have one of the only two x-ray machines in the city. Our dentists have a professional and loving reputation and are doing quality work for about 1/10 of the cost in the States. We are so happy to be able to serve the community in this vital way.



## Nutritional and Medical care

NW Nicaragua is oppressed with dietary caused sickness and death. We have felt a passion to bring health through nutritional supplementation, preventive education and medical treatment. We thank God for our medical doctor and the 4 specialists who serve their own people at ½ price.



## Ultrasound machine

After almost four years of work we finally got our portable ultrasound machine. Before the people had to travel to big cities to get a proper diagnosis but our Gynecologist and our Internist both can diagnose with our new Ultrasound machine both in our clinic and in rural clinics



## Incredible young people run this place!

Jim Bob Norman "Diego" joined the full-time team in February 2008. The mission had expanded and grown from the first community church in Candelaria to several other church plants in neighboring villages along with projects and need for accounting and communication. Diego is a servant so he jumped in with both feet and began helping in every area. He is always at the center of everything making sure that everyone has what they need and all is well. # Sustainable Organic Agriculture

2014 begins our 2-year courses for local young people to be trained in organic agriculture. Leck Heflin of Pontis, Inc. has provided Agricultural Engineer, Ernesto Blanca to train students 2 days a week. The Peace Corp will provide the business training and the Pastors will facilitate an interactive class for spiritual development to fulfill our goal to minister to them in more ways than one!

We currently have two farms, which enable us to employ church members who have been trained by Ernesto for over a year and hope to be able to buy land to plant moringa, which has the potential to move us toward sustainability
